- Five compressor rack systems • 1398 tons of CO2 refrigeration capacity • 5 hybrid gas coolers, allowing transcritical operation The heart of the system consists of 5 parallel compressor rack systems, each with 13 semi hermetic compressors Each rack is split up into three separate suction

groups; one designed at -13 for freezer

### **CO2 Cascade Industrial Refrigeration Systems**

- Lower refrigerant cost- CO 2 is about \$025 per lb
- CO 2 Systems are always operating at a positive pressure
- No ammonia is present in the food area
- CO 2 is non-hazardous and non-flammable
- Use CO 2 as a brine instead of glycol brine
- We have 60+ systems ranging from 50 TR up to 1800 TR
