Melanoma is the least common type of skin cancer in adults, but the MOST COMMON IN ADOLESCENTS Accounts for 7% of all cancers in children 15 to 19 yrs Melanoma accounts for <3% of all skin cancer, but 75% of skin cancer deaths Early stage melanoma is usually curable with surgical excision (removal) Much progress has been made since 2012 for

Jun 01, 2009 · 6 Period of Communicability *Campylobacter* Person-to-person spread is uncommon, however it has been reported among young children in child care facilities The bacteria can persist in the stool of infected individuals for 2 to 3 weeks¹ Pathogenic *E Coli* Adults typically shed the bacteria in their stool for about 1 week; children for approximately 3 weeks
