Succession Planting Gardeners can get the greatest use and production from available growing space by making companion and succession plantings Companion cropping consists of raising two vegetables in the same area at the same time One crop matures and is removed from the garden by the time the other companion is ready for harvest

planting, care & harvesting use propagator kit or rootrainer to grow roots/seedlings before planting 2 gap to leave between seeds (in cm) sow in direct sunlight sow indoors or under glass transfer to larger pot or plant in garden 1 month after sowing 5-7cm thin seedlings out (number is gap to leave between seedlings in cm) 30cm 3-10 no of days
