The Concerto for Bass Tuba by Ralph Vaughan Williams was the first concerto written for solo tuba, and remains a staple in the repertoire today The Vaughan Williams Concerto came about in the twentieth century due to the rapidly evolving role of the tuba within the orchestra, brass and military bands, eventually

At this point, Bell was clearly the leading tuba musician in the United States Consequently it was natural for him to perform the American premiere of Ralph Vaughan Williams' Concerto for Bass Tuba and Orchestra in 1955 Sealing his legacy as a giant of the tuba, Bell was sought out by Wilfred Bain, Dean of the School of Music at Indiana
