A Consular Report of Birth Abroad may be issued for any US citizen child under the age of 18 who was born abroad and who acquired US citizenship at birth Only the child's parent(s), legal guardian, person acting in loco parentis or the child may apply on the child's behalf The application generally must be signed before a US consular

### **How to Replace or Amend a Consular Report of Birth Abroad ...**

A Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA, or Form FS-240) is a document that certifies a child acquired US citizenship at birth Who can replace or amend a Consular Report of Birth Abroad: The individual listed on the birth record (if age 18 or older) A parent (for minors under age 18) or legal guardian; An authorized government agency, or

Completely filled out form DS 2029 -- Application for Consular Report of Birth Abroad To be signed by the US citizen parent(s) at the time of the interview If the US citizen parent(s) cannot be present at the interview, the form is to be signed and notarized by a US notary public or a Consular Officer at any US Embassy Complete all
