Learn basic hand embroidery stitches to create beautiful hand embroidered items  
 Blanket Stitch: The blanket stitch is worked from left to right over two imaginary lines  
 Bring the thread up at 1 and down at 2  
 Bring the thread up at 3, catching the thread from the first stitch (A)  
 Repeat (B)

 Fly Stitch Working from left to right, bring the needle up at 1 and insert at 2, leaving the thread loose  
 Bring the needle back up at 3, keeping the needle above the thread and pulling the needle toward you

 Back Stitch Back stitch is an old and adaptable stitch which can be used as a delicate outline or as a foundation in composite stitches, such as Pekinese stitch and

### **Stitch Guide - Windflower Embroidery**

the embroidery  
 Come up from the back of the work and hold the tail of the thread underneath  
 Work a tiny stitch and come back up through the centre of the stitch to split the thread  
 Waste Knot - Put a knot in the end of the thread  
 Go down into the fabric from the top at least 5-8cm (2"-3") from the start of the embroidery  
 Work the embroidery

### **How to Embroider on Denim**

the way a good embroidery design looks on a denim jacket  
 Overall, denim is a great material to work with  
 It has a fairly smooth surface and is pretty stable, which minimizes the amount of stabilizer required  
 At the same time, it is thick enough to prevent it from puckering underneath the stitches  
 All this makes for great-looking embroidery

Applique embroidery uses fabric pieces to fill in parts of a design and finishes with a smooth satin stitch

How to Tie Off Thread After you have completed a stitch you will need to tie a knot to secure the stitch from coming out/unraveling Directions: On your last stitch pull thread to wrong side of fabric Grab a small area of the fabric with the needle and stick the needle through half way Place finger on needle and wrap thread around it 3-4 times (Similar to tying a knot when fishing)
