What is Pragmatics?

Pragmatics is the study of how receivers of messages interpret utterances Pragmatics studies the use of language in human communication as determined by the conditions of society Definition 3 (socio-psychological pragmatics) Pragmatics is the study of the speaker's meaning: what does the producer of the message mean, why
