REACH and Cosmetics - CIRS

The EU Cosmetics Directive (76/768/EEC) was revised in January 2003 to ban 1,100 chemicals from cosmetics Ingredients were reviewed for safety by SCCS (EU Scientific Committee on Consumer Products) The main requirements are listed as below A safety assessment of the finished cosmetic product must be performed before the product

The CIR Expert Panel assessed the safety of crosslinked alkyl acrylates as used in cosmetics The 23 crosslinked alkyl acrylates included in this safety assessment are reported to function as absorbents, film formers, emulsion stabilizers, viscosity increasing agents, suspending agents, binders, and/or skin conditioning agents

May 08, 2018 · Safety Evaluation of Cosmetics • Safety evaluation of cosmetic ingredients is based upon the principles of the risk assessment process typically applied for chemical substances Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FD&C Act): The FD&C Act prohibits the marketing of adulterated or misbranded cosmetics in interstate commerce
