How to Ask Your Professor for a Letter of Recommendation ...

Some professors will take offense to being asked for a letter of recommendation via email Visiting the professor in office hours, scheduling an appointment, or making a phone call shows that you are willing to give up your time and energy rather than simply writing an email DO NOT ask to ...
